1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Denman Motorcycle Club , hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct a round of the Club Championship for MOTO-TRIALS.

2. JURISDICTION:

- 2.1. The above-mentioned Club meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW Limited who has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number- TBA, and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licences. To enter this event you must be either, a member of Denman MCC or The Trials Riders Association.
- 2.2. Day licenses are acceptable for this event but must be purchased prior to the event Riders Briefing.
- 2.3. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs), these Supplementary Regulations, the By-Laws of Motorcycling NSW and any final instructions.
 BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

NOTE: LATE ENTRIES MAY BE ACCEPTED OR REJECTED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE RACE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE OR CLUB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE PROMOTER.

4. INSURANCE:

- 4.1. National Capital Benefits Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Personal Accident and Ambulance Insurance is the responsibility of the individual.
- 4.3. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT SUCH INSURANCE COVER.

ENTRY FEE:

5.1. Rider ENRTY \$30 -Senior, \$20 -Junior

6. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

- 6.1. The event will have sections set for the following rider grades, and appropriate grade lines:
- A / T2 (Red Rider Name Plate, red section splits)
- B / T3 (Yellow Rider Name Plate, yellow section splits)
- C / T4 (Blue Rider Name Plate, blue section splits)
- Club/ T5 (White Rider Name Plate)
- Junior (White Rider Name Plate)



7. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

- 7.1. To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be THREE (3).
- 7.2. Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine classes will be at the discretion of the promoter.

: COMPETITION FORMAT:

Sunday, consisting of 5 sections 8 laps, four laps in the morning, lunch break and then four laps in the afternoon.

- 7.3. Competitors must present their Competition License (and log book for juniors) at sign on, to confirm their entry before the Rider's Briefing at 9:45am.
- 7.4. Results will be announced adjacent the sign on table once the event has concluded & all scores are tallied.

8. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 8.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for TRIAL MOTORCYCLES & TRIAL COMPETITION.
- 8.2. Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 8.3. A competitor may finish the trial on a machine other than their own, provided they have first obtained the approval of the MA Steward.

9. RIDING NUMBERS:

9.1. All machines MUST display a rider's nameplate that complies with the GCR rules pertaining to Trials machines.

RIDERS BRIEFING:

A Riders' briefing will be held in the area adjacent to the sign on table prior to the commencement of competition and all participants MUST attend.

Sunday riders brief 945am for a 10am start

11. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All participants, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCR's) which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this meeting and shall be enforced.

12. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

Circuit, laps and sections will be advised at the Riders Briefing.



13. <u>FINAL INSTRUCTIONS</u> Any final instructions will be provided at the Riders Briefing.
